WHY DO IT

Driven men know how to educate themselves and go after what they want, but it takes other men to help them become a man of God and win in what matters most.

BACKGROUND

In the early days of our church we tried all kinds of programs designed to reach men, from pancake breakfasts to themed weekend retreats. The lasting impact was often underwhelming because real life didn't create many opportunities for them to apply the things they were talking about. We realized that most of these men didn't understand that strengthening their relationship with Jesus would lead to thriving in their marriage, being the spiritual leader of their home, and finding fulfillment in their career. In order to help them win, men needed to understand what they were trying to do.

With that goal, 18 years ago, Pastor Jeff started leading Men's Development Groups to help men win in the areas of life that matter most. Years later, and with the insight from developing hundreds of men, Pastor Jeff wrote The Way to Win to directly address the recurring themes most beneficial in discipling men. We also learned that direct language, short chapters, and intentional discussion questions, were key to helping men engage with the material. The leaders who have come through these Development Groups have become the core spiritual leaders, financial leaders, and Serve Team leaders of Milestone Church.

4 KEYS TO DEVELOPMENT GROUP SUCCESS

SELECTION

Selection of 8-12 men. This starts by identifying leaders with the greatest potential to carry financial, spiritual, or volunteer weight in the church.

- Priests (Spiritual Leaders)
- Kings (Financial Leaders)
- Generals (People Leaders)

GROUPING

The right group leader, leading the right grouping of leaders, is the key to success. One of the greatest values of the Development Group is the opportunity to build relationships with peers that carry similar weight.

MISSION

The goal of these groups is not to just learn good concepts – the goal is to get in the game. It's to make disciples, who make disciples, and leave a legacy of faith for their families.



When is the best time to do a group?

You want to do your best to accommodate the schedules of those you are inviting, but we've found that overall, the best time is weekday mornings before work.

When it comes to choosing a time of year to start the group, we recommend starting when things start: early spring or fall.

How long is a typical group meeting?

A Development Group should be no more than one-hour of structured discussion. Anything longer will hurt attendance going forward. Close out the one-hour meeting in prayer, but then allow group members to stay and hang out longer if they wish.

Where do groups meet?

Meet at a central location, somewhere not too public, loud, or distracting. A conference room at someone's office or a meeting space at the church with a large table to sit around is ideal.

How many men are in each group?

This can vary widely but we've found around ten men to be a good number. You want the group to be large enough that it's not too intimate, but small enough that it provides everyone an opportunity to share. 8-12 is a great goal.

What happens between group meetings?

The Development Group leader must be willing to commit his time and energy to the group members outside the structured meeting in order for discipleship to happen. This involves taking phone calls, texts, scheduling activities, and praying for the individual members of the group. Also look for opportunities to hang out and gather spouses together.
