In our world, we have more options and more information about what everyone else is doing than any previous generation. It's no wonder we're all a little anxious and worried about missing out.

### THE FOUNDATIONS BOOK

We need a plan, a guide that helps us understand what really matters so we can make the right choices. Without a plan, we are left to live from choice to choice, hoping things work out. Unfortunately, this is where too many of us end up. Twenty-five-hundred years ago, the philosopher Socrates famously said, "The unexamined life is not worth living."

We all build on something—and the foundation you choose determines the life you live.

In **John 17**, Jesus is moments away from being arrested. In less than 24 hours, He'll be beaten and die the most excruciating death imaginable on a cross along a busy road. Before this happens, Jesus prays and asks God for help. In this prayer, He gives us an insight into what really matters in life.

When Jesus says in **John 17:3**, "Now, this is eternal life..." He is speaking about more than the quantity of life—a life that never ends. He's talking about the quality of life—the life we were created to live.

The life we were all created to live is built on the foundation of knowing God and Jesus Christ, the One God sent to be with us. This is the life that is truly life. Jesus came to make this abundant life available to any of us who would receive Him.

This is more than knowing information about Him. It means to know and

be known, to walk with Him, to trust Him when we don't understand, and to see the reality of His presence in every area of our lives.

A man named Paul experienced this firsthand. He went from persecuting those who followed Jesus to developing a genuine, personal relationship with Him. And God used him to help establish the early church. Through great opposition, danger, and supernatural outcomes, Paul planted churches, trained leaders, and preached the message of Jesus throughout the Roman Empire. His letters to churches make up a large percentage of the New Testament.

In his first letter to the church located in the first-century city of Corinth, Paul is frustrated because the people are being foolish. They're fighting with each other over foolish personal preferences. They're building on a foolish plan. They have the wrong foundation.

Paul says that it was by God's grace that he laid a foundation like a skilled master builder. In **1 Corinthians 3:11**, Paul tells us that there's only one foundation for a wise person to build on: Jesus Christ.


How did the crowds respond to Jesus' teaching? Why did they react this way? (verses 28-29)

Jesus' teaching on the wise and foolish builders is among His most well-known. Maybe you've heard it before. But when you think about it, it's bold. It's aggressive. It's a long way from "Follow your heart" or "Do what makes you happy."

Consider for a moment the basic premise. The question is not, "Will we face rain, floods, or winds?" Whatever words we choose to use, the meaning remains the same. Every single person will face challenging circumstances. You could say all of us are in one of three places at any given time in our lives: (1) in a storm, (2) coming out of a storm, or (3) headed for a storm.

The question is, "What foundation are you building on?" Because ultimately, building your own kingdom can't hold up to the floods and challenges of life, and it will leave you insecure, anxious, and hopeless in your own strength.

Anytime people in the ancient world thought about buildings and foundations, they thought about the concept of a "cornerstone." In architecture, particularly with stone, the cornerstone is the most vital piece of the foundation. Not only does it fasten and secure the foundation, but it sets the alignment of the entire structure.



Every other stone fits into its place based on its relationship with the cornerstone. Until it's secure, nothing else can be built. **Psalm 118** is a song about God's goodness and how He offers salvation, and in verse 22 it says, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." It's a prophetic picture of how God offers Jesus as the foundation. In **Isaiah 28:16**, God says He lays a precious cornerstone and the one who relies on it will never panic.

God wants you to build your life on Jesus. He has a plan for everything you care about in life. But without Jesus as the cornerstone, when the storms come, everything will come crashing down.

How are you building? Whether we acknowledge it or not, we all have a cornerstone. It could be your career, family, finances, or yourself and your own plans. While these things are good, and God has a purpose for them all, they ultimately can be shaken and washed away—that's what Jesus is telling us in **Matthew 7**.

# SOMETHING ETERNAL TO PLACE OUR TRUST IN AND BUILD OUR IIVES IIPON

We need something eternal to place our trust in and build our lives upon. Jesus offers Himself as the chief cornerstone of our lives. The question is, "Will you not only hear Jesus' words, but will you also do them?"

Remember, it's not about what you know or don't know. Jesus is after your heart. Will you trust Him? Will you say yes and keep taking steps to follow Him?

You can do it and this journey is designed to help you get there.
