<b>VALUES 301</b> 7-week class comprising of 35 min teaching, 45 min small group  Connect with others, grow spiritually and learn about our core values for Christian living that forms the culture and DNA of Milestone Church. 301 is a great way to build relationships with others. We've designed the class with a desire to help you develop friendships through a small group experience.  Monday class (7-8:30pm) start Jan, Mar, Jun, Sep Sunday class (5-6.30pm) start Feb and Oct	<b>KELLER CAMPUS:</b>  Sundays: January 21st - March 3rd 5:00pm - 6:30pm  Mondays: March 18th - April 29th 7:00pm - 8:30pm
<b>CONNECT:</b> Church wide series and specific studies (couples, singles, co-ed, men's and women's)	
<b>MARRIAGE &amp; PARENTING:</b> Specific studies on topics	
<b>PRE-MARRIAGE:</b> Pre-Engagement / Pre-Marriage groups through to one year of Marriage	
<b>MILESTONE STEWARDSHIP MINISTRY:</b> This class is designed to help you save, give, and live debt free. During the class, you'll learn how to create a budget and steward your resources from a biblical perspective. You'll also get to connect with others in a Small Group setting. On average, families who go through the Stewardship Class at Milestone pay off \$1,100 in debt and save \$700 during this class alone!	
<b>FREEDOM:</b> A nine-week small group designed to help remove the things that hinder you from a deeper relationship with God so that you can live the life God has for you. It ends with "Freedom Weekend", which is a Friday evening and Saturday.	
<b>RESTORE:</b> <b>FOUNDATIONS &amp; REDEMPTION TRACK:</b> If you are experiencing a past hurt or current struggle, Restore is a small group environment that teaches how to have a dynamic relationship with Jesus. We also have dynamic leaders dedicated to your growth and committed to see you win.  <b>GRIEF SHARE:</b> The Bible teaches how to deal with the loss of a loved one and the Grief Share small group setting helps people discover how to begin a new chapter in life.  <b>EVERY MAN'S BATTLE:</b> This powerful 8-week small group study teaches men how to be husbands, dads, sons, leaders and Christ-followers committed to purity, holiness and living God's way. These men are learning to live in victory and freedom and meet on campus each Monday night.	

## THINGS TO REMEMBER:

### Before Class:

- Have your nametag, lanyard & paperwork (Connector Sheet & Spiritual Gifts cheat sheet) ready
- Find Table Number (see map) and sit at worst seat
- \* *Gluten free lunches are by the audio desk*

### Guests:

- Our goal is to get to know them, help connect them to place to serve that is a good fit for them
- Get them talking to each other. God has Divine Appointments for them
- Use your hospitality gift. It is easy!
- \* *Encourage them to not leave empty seats when class is expected to be full*

**A Home:** People are coming today looking for something - a place to serve using their gifts, friends, fun & experience Spiritual Family

### The Living Room:

- Make the room feel comfortable, laid back
- Introduce yourself and explain your role as a Connector (answer any questions, help guide them through the Growth Track and help them make connections as a relational broker).
- \* *Best connectors immediately begin thinking: who in the church do they need to meet?*

### Icebreaker Questions / Talking points:

- How long have you been coming to Milestone?
- Have you been through 101 or 301 yet (helps you talk through next steps)
- Are you originally from Texas?
- Do you have kids, family members or friends attending? (capacity/season of life)
- What do you do for a living? (you're listening for skill set - things they enjoy or dislike)
- Tell me about where you have served in a church or a non-profit before - what did you do?
- Introduce everyone to one another (we're there to get to know them but also to help them get to know one another and make connections).
- Give an overview of what Serve Team 201 is (learning about different ministries to serve using their gifts)

### Next Steps:

- 101 (if they haven't already attended - important for them to attend)
- 301 - next step in the Growth Track - the Big Goal

### End of Class:

- Encourage everyone to finish paperwork filling in their spiritual gifts and experience
- Make sure they have marked Number "1" and "2" for their first and second choice
- If they are interested in Missions (but it's not their 1st choice) - tell them to check Missions and the team will follow up with a text/email with more information on how to serve.
- **THEY WILL TAKE THEIR PAPERWORK TO THEIR BREAKOUT**
- Only collect the paperwork for those people not ready to serve yet (or if they leave early)

### Connector Form:

- Take notes of your guests **\*\*\*Add your name at top (or stick your name tag at end)**
- Make notes from the conversations you had that will help you to remember each person & connect with them
- Any notes help give us insight into each person/family as we don't always get to meet everyone during the class.
