
SIN


Sin separates us from God. Sin is anything we say, think, or do that goes against God's way. Our human nature is to sin because we're born in sin.

Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.






THE BEST GIFT EVER

THE OLD

Before you are saved, your life is shaped by your sin. Sin isn't just one particular thing that comes out of your heart; sin can take place in your life in many different ways.

SINFUL ACTIONS THAT COULD TAKE PLACE IN YOUR LIFE:

- Yelling at or disobeying your parents
- Taking something that's not yours
- Being mean to your siblings
- Talking back to your teacher at school

EPHESIANS 2:1-2a (NLT)

Once you were dead because of your disobedience and your many sins. You used to live in sin, just like the rest of the world.

THE NEW

Baptism doesn't save you, but when you are baptized it symbolizes your sin being washed away, and you come out of the water with new life found in Jesus. You still have to choose to obey, but remember, Jesus lives inside you and will help you!

NEW LIFE WITH JESUS COULD LOOK LIKE:

- You are full of love and joy
- You want to respect and obey your parents
- You are kind to your siblings
- You have a loving attitude toward others

We all make mistakes, but when you do make a bad choice, you feel sorry and ask for God's forgiveness. You don't need to get baptized again.

COLOSSIANS 2:12 (NIRV)

When you were baptized, you were buried together with Christ. And you were raised to life together with him when you were baptized. You were raised to life by believing in God's work. God himself raised Jesus from the dead.

ROMANS 6:4 (NIRV)

By being baptized, we were buried with Christ into his death. Christ has been raised from the dead by the Father's glory. And like Christ we also can live a new life.


2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

PARENTS, take some time to discuss how baptism is an outward picture of an inward decision.


WHY?


