







Katelyn came into camp not just believing God for what He could do n her life but also praying for her brother, Thomas, to be marked by God.




Corbin gave his life to Jesus last year. Since then, he's been taking steps to reach his friends for Jesus.

He invited his friend Brayden to Week 1 of Super Series, and that night Brayden gave his life to Jesus!



We praise God for what He is doing in Bella and Noah! 🙌

























