SUPER SERIES STRATEGY



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THE WHY

Super Series is a 3 week evangelistic series, with a goal to make it easy for students to reach their lost friends for Jesus.



Principles

Principle #1. Consistency in the same direction for a long time.

- We have been running this play for over 15 years. Consistency can actually produce greater results than innovation.

Principle #2. Anything of value will take time to build.

- There is no “silver bullet” type of program to build momentum. It all takes time to build into a culture.

Principle #3. Be faithful with little, God will let you steward more.

- We can tend to think, “I want to reach more students!” Build the ones you have, and they’ll build the church.



Practicals

Practical #1. Building leaders (the net).

- You never outgrow the steps of discipleship and building leaders.
Don't focus on building a big ministry; focus on building big people.
- You must see the vision for the value added to leaders to be part of your youth ministry. You will only recruit sharp leaders if you really believe it will add something to them they can't get anywhere else. If you don't see it, you won't recruit like it

Practical #2. Mobilizing students to reach their friends.

- Getting God's heart for evangelism in students. Emphasize the spiritual component: it's not just "invite your friend," it's "share your faith."

Practical #3. Stay consistent with your evangelism approach.

- A lot of times we don't see lasting momentum because we abandon ship too quickly.



SUPER SERIES GAME PLAN



Super Series

Game Plan

Below are the key elements of Super Series that we always have in place.

1. Evangelism series leading up to Super Series

- For 3-4 weeks, we spend time preaching about God's heart for the lost, and creating intentional moments in service to pray for lost people.

2. Street Teams

- Empowering specific selected students to reach their friends
- See "Street Team Strategy" below for full details of Street Teams

3. "Beauses" - Reasons why new people will come

- Free food for everyone
- Free shirts for first time guests & bringers
- Photo booths / games
- See "Shareables Examples" section for more

4. Evangelistic Service

- Keep it simple and Gospel focused! The whole point is bringing it to a salvation altar call.
- The whole service is geared towards the NEW and LOST person. This is delivered through worship leaders' clear vocal cues, how the preacher is explaining Jesus & salvation, and how announcements are communicated. Lean away from using church-y words a lost person wouldn't understand without explanation.

5. Leader recruiting

- Recruit specifically for these 3 weeks (not long term commitment)
- At minimum, double regular adult volunteer number for Super Series (if current average is 50 adult leaders, aim for 100 adult leaders)
- Where do additional volunteers go? Beef up existing teams (a few more on ushers, check-in, first time guests, etc) and add in additional teams (photo booths, food, Salvation & Prayer teams, outside presence, etc)

6. Salvation Room & Prayer Time

- For each Super Series, we give a specific salvation altar call where students respond to the front, we do a group prayer, and dismiss them to a pre-set room with adult leaders to talk one-on-one about the decision to follow Jesus
- In the salvation room, there will be circles of chairs for 1-2 leaders and 3-5 students to sit down. Leaders take time to hear the students' stories, and help them understand what God did in their hearts.
- Before students are dismissed out of this room, leaders give them next steps (baptism, coming back, small groups, etc) and have them fill out salvation form to document each person who got saved so we can follow up with them
- We have an additional team remain in the worship center to pray with students for other prayer needs outside of salvation

7. Follow-up

- Our staff follows up individually with every student that got saved the next day, as well as let their parents know about this decision. We help these students walk through a Bible reading plan & help them take next steps.

8. Sharing Stories

- Prioritize sharing stories with staff, volunteers, and on social media

Why Street Teams?

Empowering influential students to reach their friends during Super Series.

What is a Street Team?

Hand selected students from certain schools we equip to reach their friends.

Strategy

Process For Street Teams

- Identify teams from each school within your sphere of influence
- Rally teams 2 times: 4 weeks & 3 weeks before before Super Series after a youth night (The first time is vision casting, encouragement to them, and resourcing them. The second time is laying out specific expectations for being on the team and talking practically about how to reach their friends)
- Host a prayer night the week of Super Series at someone's house (have food & hang out, worship together, specific prayer points / guided prayers, keep them focused on the specific students they are going after to reach, and encourage them that God is with them)
- Consistent texting
 - Create group texts 5 weeks out out for each school
 - Text about street team rally
 - Encourage them to be thinking of 1 friend to bring who is lost
 - 2 weeks out, text about prayer night
 - Week of, text about prayer night
 - Each week of Super Series:
 - Mon text encouraging them to be bold in faith / praying for you
 - Tue text giving specifics of graphics to post / text friends
 - Wed morning "GAME DAY" text
 - Wed night / Thursday celebratory text with stats on first time guests and salvations from their school



Street Team

Strategy

- Choose 1-2 key students from within the Street Teams to focus on
 - Each pastor or leader overseeing street teams should identify 1-2 students to be hyper intentional with
 - Know the names of friends they're praying for
 - Have at least 1 time before super series meeting with them one-on-one talking about what God's doing in their heart, strategy to reach their friends, etc

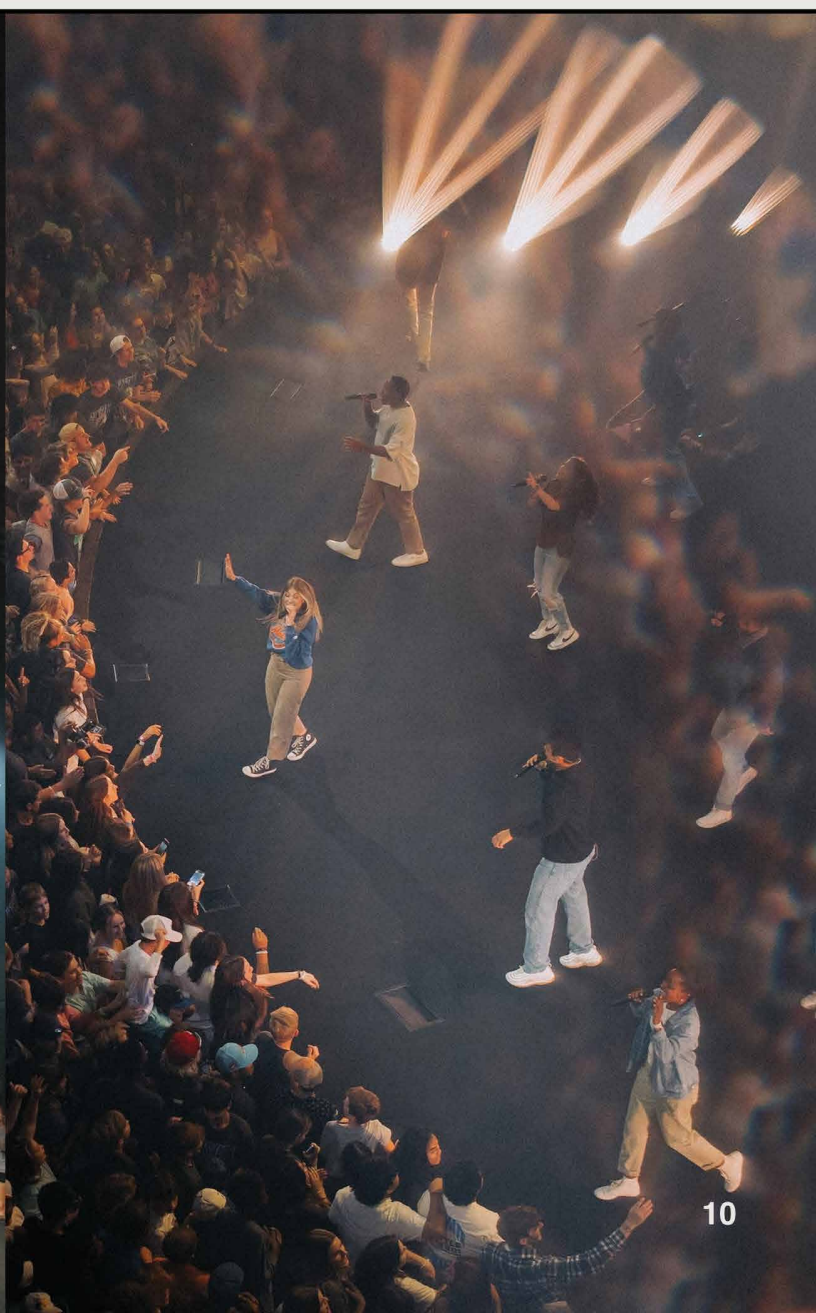
Commitment from Street Team members:

1. Commit to pray for your school, and ask God to highlight people he wants you to reach
2. Share your faith and invite your friends!
3. Wear Elevate shirt on Wednesdays at your school during Super Series
4. Hand out invite cards to friends
5. Use your social media & text friends with shareables to promote Super Series

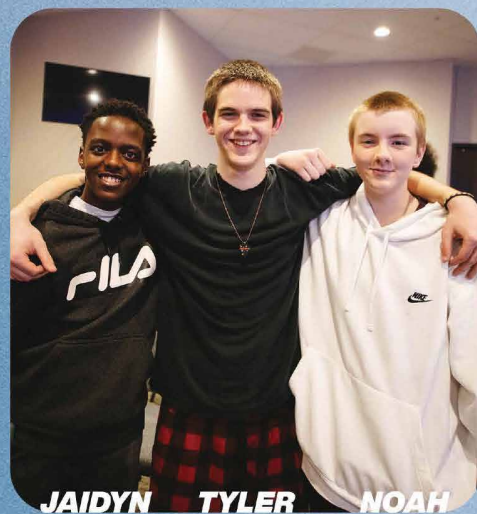
From the moment she walked through the doors, Manvitha felt welcomed and loved. She said, "I feel like I belong, I feel God's love, and I know I'm not alone."

During the salvation moment, all three of them raised their hands to get saved! They each felt God speak to them and are now excited to reach others in their school for Jesus.

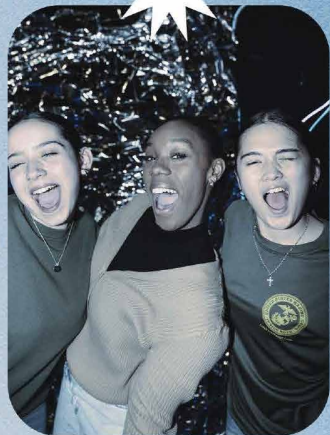

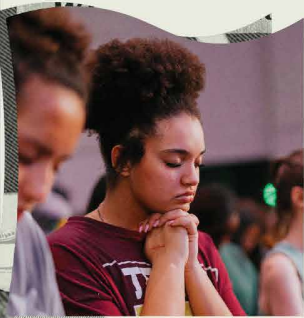

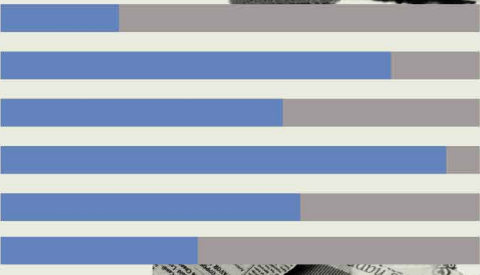


We are amazed at what God did night 1 of Super Series! The whole service was focused on the theme of being “anxious about nothing” by experiencing God’s peace. Hundreds of students were impacted by God’s presence & his love!

When the call for salvation was given, the altar was full of students responding. 92 girls & 60 boys came forward! 61 of those students filled out a form telling us they received salvation, and heaven only knows how many more made a real faith decision to follow Jesus.

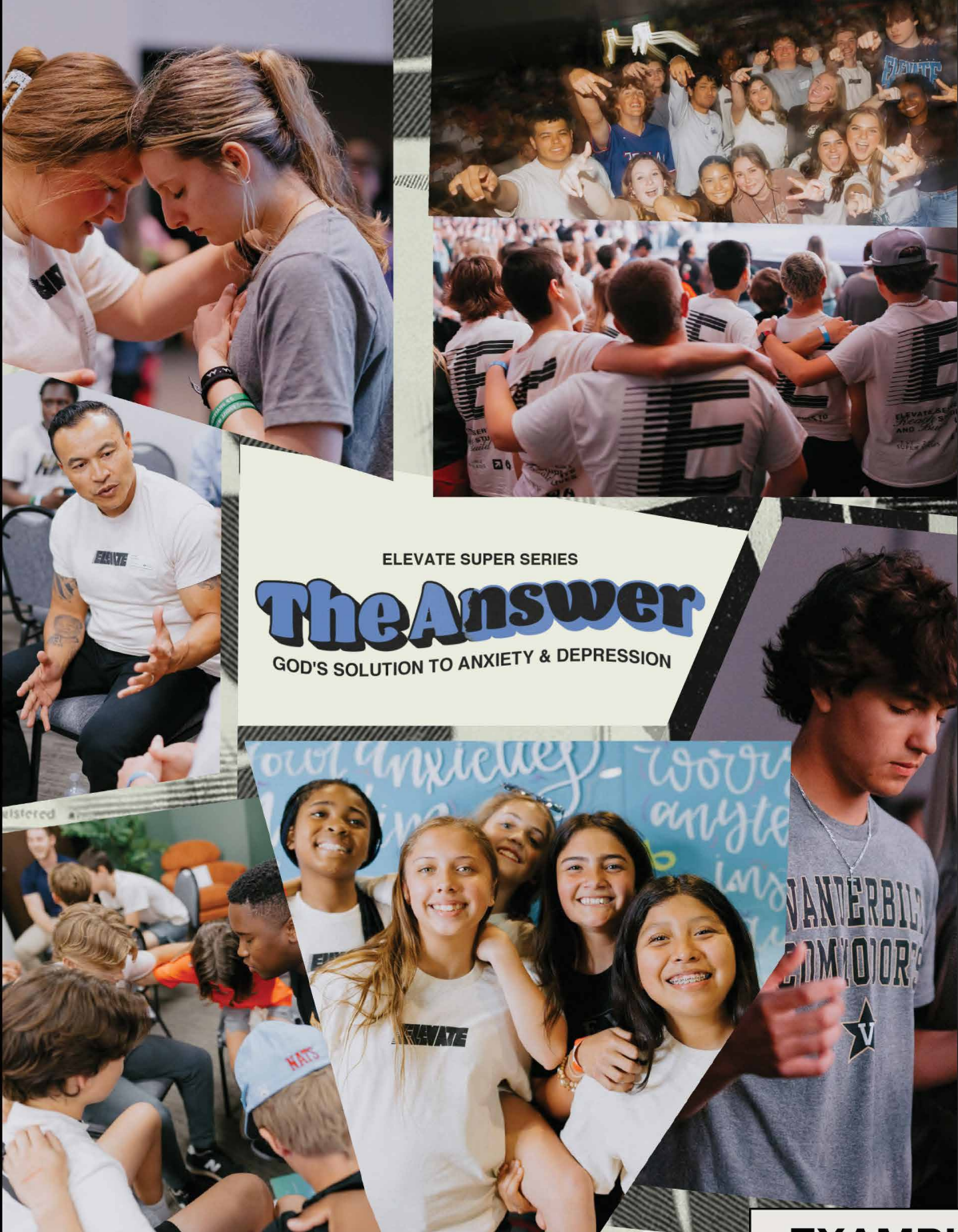
Joseph

BYRON NELSON BASKETBALL TEAM



Lorenzo has been praying for the guys on his basketball team for the past year. He said, "I have always felt a heart to try and bring my basketball teammates to Christ because I have grown so close with these guys from basketball."

Leading up to Super Series, he continued to pray and ask God to help him reach his friends. They didn't come week 1, and Lorenzo was a little discouraged, but kept on believing for them. Leading up to week 2, Lorenzo convinced all of them to come. Lorenzo said, "I prayed before that God would speak to them tonight and that they would have an encounter with God. When pastor Drew asked people to raise their hand to give their lives to Christ they all had their hands raised. We all walked down to the front and I got to pray with them as they got saved. Maria Varela has served at Elevate for the past year.

Her sister, Lyssandra, is a freshman (15 year age difference between the sisters). Since Maria got saved she's felt a burden in her heart to pray over her siblings' salvation. She used to worry so much for them until one day the Lord said to her, "Let me worry about my children." Since then, she began prayer for the salvation of her loved ones.

Every Wednesday since she's started serving, Maria has invited her sister in hopes that she would accept her invitation. She finally came for the first time the week before

Super Series by herself and left feeling "lighter." Lyssandra said she felt like she had a peace she's never experienced before after her first time attending.

She came again for Super Series week 2, and said that she felt the Lord tell her, "You are not alone, and you will never have to carry any of it alone. I am with you."

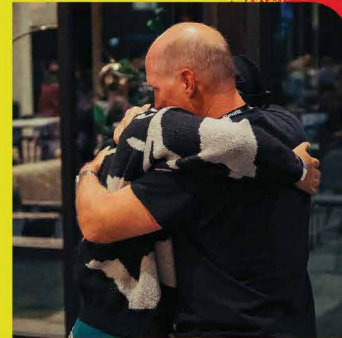
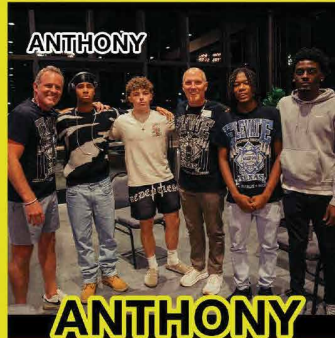
She accepted Jesus into her heart because of how loved she's felt! Lyssandra said, "I want to be with God forever!"

"I've been going through a lot of pain recently," Anthony said. "I'm just so grateful I came tonight and I'm so glad my friend brought me here for the first time. God saved me today! I now feel close to God. Now I know someone is with me when I go through difficult times in my life."



Kristin, a sophomore has gotten invited by friends to Elevate for a long time and finally decided to come. She said, "It felt personal when the pastor was sharing His story and I knew that God was speaking to me... I have struggled with feeling alone, but after tonight I can see everything clearer. I can see the reason & purpose, for the moments that led up to me being here tonight. I now feel lighter and like a weight has been lifted."

Chelsie, a senior, has felt that God has been seeking after her for a while. She knew about Elevate and wanted to come, but didn't want to come alone. Someone from her school reached out and invited her through an Instagram post. She prayed the salvation prayer in her seat but was nervous to come to the front. After service she found an adult leader and asked, "How do I get to the room where I get saved?" She knew that she wanted to be in that room. Chelsie said, "I have felt for awhile God has been seeking me and tonight felt right. I know I didn't go to the front like everyone else, but I prayed the prayer at my seat and felt God's presence."

MARSHALL + DILLON

Last week at Elevate was Marshall's first time to ever come to a church and he got saved! This week, he brought his brother, Dillon, with him as well, and Dillon also gave his life to Jesus!



SKY

During the message, Sky (a 6th grader), felt seen and felt God was telling her to raise her hand and accept Him into her heart.

Olivia felt nervous to invite her but finally, on September 25, the day of Super Series week 2, she got the courage to invite Kenzie.

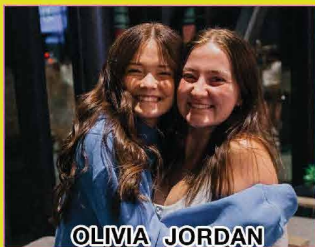

After she received Jesus into her heart, Jordin said, "I felt instant relief and encouragement to start this new chapter alongside my friends."

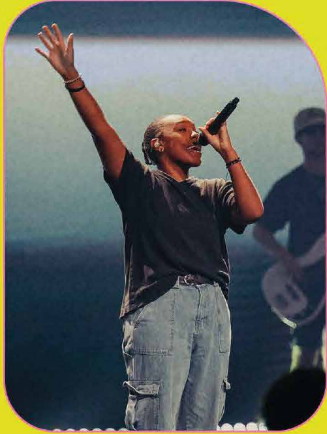
